Other Business Discussion

The committee reviewed the process for when they are ready to order books and how they will spend their money. They decided to get updated pricing from J&A, Cedar Graphics, and Fisher Group for the cost of printing the books. The committee discussed whether they would prefer to see more pictures in the book or more text descriptions and what whether the books should be printed in hard back or spiral bound. Rooks would like to see more pictures of people and places and would prefer a spiral bound book. James was concerned that a spiral bound copy wouldn't hold up as well and would prefer a hard bound book. Ask would prefer a hard bound copy as it is nicer. Semelroth indicated that the original thought was more of a picture book than a reading book. The Commission considered a soft bound book rather than hard bound or spiral.

Semelroth discussed the possibility of setting up a booth at Fun Fest instead of being in the parade. She will follow up with Kelly Willadsen.
