Reports:

- **Fun Fest 2017: August 25-26th, 2017.** Thank you for those of you that volunteered during the festivities, we greatly appreciate it! We hope you had a great time this year and were able to enjoy all the free activities and entertainment! We had over 1,000 people in attendance from Friday to Saturday's events. There were over 300 people in attendance for the 8 Seconds band along with the Movie Under the Moon. We kicked off Saturday with 82 walkers/runners participating in the Fireman's 5K, over 120 hungry pancake eaters at the HiCREW Kiwanis Pancake Breakfast, 50 different parade floats handing out candy and tons of families enjoying a day of FUN!
