

The Hiawatha History Commission met on August 12, 2019, at Hiawatha City Hall in Conference Room D with Pat Semelroth as Chair calling the meeting to order at 2:20 P.M. Members present: Merry Rooks, Marilyn James, and Carol Johnson.

Business:

Merry Rooks moved the approval of the agenda, seconded by Marilyn James. Motion carried.

The Commission discussed the upcoming Insights Article topics. They decided to use the History of the Farmers Market for September. Johnson will look into the History and who is in charge of the farmer's market.

They discussed having fire prevention for the month of October and using the parks for November, December and January newsletters.

Book Finances

Semelroth said they will be receiving \$200.00 from McGrath from their grant for the book.

They discussed a \$5,000.00 estimate from a vendor in regards to print 250 copies of the book.

They discussed sending out another letter to businesses to request donations or selling sponsorships and to not send the letter to those who have already sent money in. Also discussed putting something in the Insights about having pre-orders available for the book if possible.

The Commission brainstormed ideas with having a map with the different places in Hiawatha and having something small at each location. An open house idea where people would move from location to location.

They also discussed having it be more adult focused and having no parade.

Other Business Discussion

The Commission discussed looking for a binder of pictures of all of the people who have been interviewed by them.
