Thank you for participating in our House Check Program. While you are away, officers will check and help keep an extra eye on your home. In addition, you can follow these simple crime prevention tips to help protect your home and belongings. You can give the impression your home is occupied by placing a light or a radio on a timer. Have your mail placed on hold or have someone pick it up for you. Stop your newspaper from being delivered and turn off your phone ringers. Also, don't forget to have someone mow your lawn or remove the snow from your driveway and sidewalks.

Other tips that could be helpful are to make certain you lock and secure all of your windows, doors, and garage. If it is possible place your important or expensive valuables such as cash, jewelry, or coins in a safe deposit box. Also, do not share that your home will be vacant to anyone and only share this with trusted family, friends or neighbors. Do not leave your vehicle(s) parked in the street as they will be ticketed and or impounded at your expense.

I understand that the house checks will be conducted frequently, although not necessarily daily, and that officers will not enter locked gates or back yards if animals are present. I will hold harmless the City of Hiawatha, the Hiawatha Police Department, and all its employees and agents for any and all claims of personal injury, loss, or damage to property that may be suffered through any action or lack thereof by a representative of the City of Hiawatha. I will call the Hiawatha Police Department when I return home to cancel this house check.
