Reports:

- We are patiently waiting for County to approve the dog park land agreements, once those are approved we will be getting to work on tree removal and weed control. We are excited to get the process started!
- Kim and I have been meeting with MSA Planning Professionals on the NW Territory Park planning and Master Plan quotes. We believe pairing the projects together will be beneficial in creating a new park and learning about what our residents would like to see over the next ten years. This planning process will include the Commissions help and feedback, along with the community and Council. We are excited for what is coming our way and hope you are too!




